

Keyholders: (Appendix A)

Keyholders are appointed at the discretion of the committee. These individuals are responsible for running regular club sessions. Private boat owners who pay racking fees to the club may also possess personal keys.

The committee reserves the right to revoke keyholder status at any time. Reasons for revocation may include, but are not limited to:

- Unsafe practices
 - Damage to equipment due to negligence
 - Improper care or handling of club equipment
 - Failure to follow club policies or procedures
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Rowing Outside of Designated Sessions:

To ensure the validity of the club's insurance policy, members wishing to row in club boats outside of scheduled sessions must request that a Keyholder or session leader open the club and lead an additional session open to all members. This is entirely at the discretion of the session leader and should be considered an exception rather than a regular practice. All off-session rowing must be coordinated through the club's WhatsApp group.

Members are strongly encouraged to participate in scheduled club sessions.

Access for Private Boat Owners: (Appendix B)

Keyholding members who pay to rack private boats may access their personal equipment at any time. However, it is important to note that this activity is considered separate from official club operations. WCRC accepts no responsibility for any damage or injury resulting from private use.
